PACKING LIST

Alpine Camp and Conference Center is located a mile high in the beautiful San Bernardino mountains. The weather is subject to change frequently, and it is important to come prepared with the right clothing and items for all types of weather and exploration. Most of the program will take place outside in the elements. To help you have the best experience at camp possible, it is recommended that you bring the following items:

FOR ALL SEASONS

- Bible (Christian schools only)
- Pencil, pen, notebook, or folder
- Duffle bag, suitcase, or backpack
- Sleeping bag or bedding and pillow
- Socks and underwear (bring extra)
- Short sleeved shirts
- Shorts (optional)
- Long pants
- Sweatshirt or long sleeved shirt
- Hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen
- Warm jacket
- Tennis shoes or hiking boots (no sandals, please)
- Toiletry items (soap, towel, washcloth, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Water bottle or canteen

IF COMING TO CAMP FROM OCTOBER THROUGH APRIL, YOU SHOULD BRING THE ADDITIONAL ITEMS...

- Long underwear
- Gloves or mittens
- Warm socks and extra pairs
- Warm boots
- Scarf
- Stocking hat or beanie
- Rain poncho

OTHER ITEMS YOU MAY ALSO WANT TO BRING ALONG...

- Camera and film
- Money for Gift shop (items range from 50 cents to 30 dollars)

PLEASE LEAVE AT HOME THE FOLLOWING:

- Electronic game or devices—iPods, Nintendos, PS3's, Discmans, etc. You get the picture!
- Fireworks, pocket knives, or any kind of weapons
- Cell phones are at the discretion of your teacher—you won't need it while at camp and probably won't get a signal anyhow!
